West Park United recommends the following guidelines on:

## **PARENTS/GUARDIANS CONDUCT**

- Let the Coaches coach
- Be patient and supportive with young/youth players
- Emphasise good behaviour at all times
- Enjoy the game and highlight good play from both teams and promote positive play
- Exercise self-control when a goal is scored or lost
- Understand and support the Laws of the Game & accept the match supervisor/officials decisions
- Never use bad language or threatening behaviour
- Never criticise any match supervisor/official, player, coach or official
- Never enter the field of play
