The following Codes of Conduct have been devised by West Park United and are based on the concept of fair play, defined by:

1. Respect for the rules
2. Respect for the referees and their decisions
3. Respect for all participants, including team-mates, coaches and opponents
4. Equal participation (where appropriate)
5. Maintaining self-control at all times

West Park United recommends the following guidelines on:

PLAYERS CONDUCT

- Play fairly and encourage your team-mates
- Display good sportsmanship at all times
- Never make fun of your opponents or be unsporting when scoring a goal
- Be prepared by arriving on time and with the proper equipment
- Be prepared physically and mentally for both training and matches
- Be positive in your thoughts and actions
- Enjoy the game and have fun, regardless of the result
- Never use foul or abusive language to either your team-mates or opponents
- Show respect to your coaches and to your opponents
- Show respect to the Supervisor/Referee and respect their decisions
- Never use foul or abusive language to the Supervisor/Referee
- As a representative of West Park, you must behave well and in an appropriate manner at all times
- Always, regardless of the result, shake hands with your opponents at the end of the game
